OUTCOME ACHIEVED AT THE END OF ACADEMIC YEAR 2009 - 2010

- 1. Prepared and submitted the proposal for the permanent affiliation with parent University, North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon.
- 2. Efforts are being made to prepare the proposal of 12 (B).
- 3. A conscious attempt is being made about the use of alternative teaching methods like the use of advanced teaching aids, group discussions, seminars, web based education, role playing, etc. in addition to power point presentations and articles presentations on PCs, Laptops, OHPs, etc. This method is adopted by all departments in Arts and Science faculty.
- 4. Trees are planted in the campus for helping in minimizing the pollution. To make awareness in controlling pollution, college planted trees by students. Awareness about pollution has been created among the students by such programs.
- 5. Few plant species, those are difficult to purchase, were collected during the study tour by the Botany department and developed those species in the garden. Such collection saves the money and time of the institution to get the plant species for dissection and analyses.
- 6. The construction of wall compound of the college has been started and drinking water tank is completed.
- 7. Attention was also given on the regular maintenance, repairing and increase of infrastructural facilities in the campus. College requests to Hon'ble governing council for such work, as the college is not receiving the development grants from UGC or any other statutory body.
- 8. Study tours were organized by most of the departments from Arts and Science faculties to widen the horizons of student's knowledge.
- 9. The efforts are continued for student's motivation to prepare for competitive examinations and to tune their careers in proper directions. Few students are appointed in various technical departments on various posts and few are recruited

- as police constables. Few students enrolled for research work and many enrolled for PG degrees.
- 10. Alumni are kept in better networking, by telephone, e-mails or by presence. Few alumni declared and provided the financial support to poor, needy and deserving students, to departments, etc.
- 11. Popular lectures of eminent personalities are held at special occasions viz. World environment day, National Blind Day, Blood donation day, National science day, etc.
- 12. Faculties and students from science faculty participated in the research festival named as "AVISHKAR-2009" conducted by North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon in December 2009. Students from F. Y. B. Sc. Class presented their article in National seminar orally, conducted by Dept. of Environmental Science, North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. Many Teachers involved in research activities, viz. to attend the International, National, State level seminars / conferences / symposia / workshops, etc. and to present the research articles in the events.
- 13. Students are being encouraged by Principal to participate in sports activities. College conducts inter collegiate sports events, which are fully funded by the college.
- 14. College runs the activities smoothly by appointing the faculties from Teaching and Non Teaching Staff on various internal bodies, by Principal.
- 15. Periodic purchasing of chemicals, tools, instruments, etc. as a part of infrastructural development are being made as and when required. The demands are put forth by the heads of the respective departments. The purchasing committee decides and finally, Principal delivers orders for the demands.
- 16. Additional facilities to students such as educational tools (viz. note book, pen, pencils, chalks, ink, files and folders, pages, chocolates, tutorial books, practical hand books, etc), photocopies of documents and public telephone services, etc. are being provided under one roof, which has been situated near the office.
