## 3.4.1: Outcomes of Extension activities in the neighbourhood community in terms of impact and sensitizing the students to social issues for their holistic development during the last five years.

Even today people of the society are not aware about their health, hygiene and diseases in most places of Parola taluka area. So many citizens and villagers suffering from various diseases like malaria, diarrhea, Cancer, HIV-AIDS, etc. Therefore, various social activities for awareness of health, hygiene and diseases are implemented through NSS, Sports, and Student development department of our college. Girls volunteer made the mask himself sitting on sewing machine. Masks were distributed free of cost to rural women and men and aware the villagers.

Volunteer launched campaign to inform people about the importance of sanitization.

College students along with police personnel, challenge people not to leave their homes without important work.
