

The Government of India formulated the national policy for persons with disabilities in February 2006 which deals with educational rehabilitation of persons with disabilities, therefore in view of this COER has implemented these policies in the teaching and learning process. The COER's policy recognizes that persons with disabilities are valuable human resource for the institution and seeksto create an environment that provides equal opportunities, protection of their rights and full participation in the academic environment.



The focus of the policy is on the following:

- To ensure that the design of the building such as ramp/ lift should be according to the disabled persons.
- To ensure the accessible, gender-sensitive, safe, usable, and functionalwashroom facilities should be provided for disabled persons.
- To ensure the proper text and pictogram signage such as tactile path, lights, display boards, signposts are necessary, located to be visible and touchable.
- The use of signage of male and female symbols, in accordance with local Customs and standards, with raised outlines and bright color contrast will bemore evident to everyone and particularly helpful for persons with visual Impairments.
- Learners with disabilities need to be adequately and appropriately supported inand out of the classroom with the right resources and assistive technology, and with leadership, teaching staff and college communities that are responsive to their needs.
- To ensure the accessibility of software tools and technology for the people withdisabilities.
- Provision for enquiry and information: Human assistance, reader, scribe, softcopies of reading material, screen reading etc.
- A special seating arrangement will be provided to these students by the collegewith prior information in case of avoidable emergency case.
- Extra time will be provided as per university norms.
- 10. The requirement of differently abled students may be located ad place where it is easily accessible to everyone.
- 11. Eligible writers for the examination will be provided as per the demand from the needy student.

Types of facilities:

1. Ramps-

The Ramps are built through the campus where uneven floor levels or kerbs are present to provide convenience and prevent tripping accidents. Ramps are helpful to push a pallet truck, trolley, or wheel chair over a kerb or step by negotiating just a few inches of height difference. Utility ramps solve the problem and make wheeled movement between uneven levels very easy.
